

RCCA E1000

Rules for E1000 Class:

1. With the exception of the following restrictions, all RCCA Open class rules, and scoring will be used.
2. Aircraft must be powered by one battery no larger than 11.1Wh (Example: 11.1V x 1Ah = 11.1Wh)
3. Battery:
 - A) Pilots can use different cell count, capacity, and chemistry as long as the Volts x mAh is not greater than the class limit.
 - B) Battery may NOT be switched out during the round.
 - C) Battery must be secured with a safety strap around the battery or have a hatch that is screwed or bolted.
4. Sticky fluids/sprays (i.e. Tanglefoot/honey) and sandpaper/tread tape are NOT allowed. Double-sided tape will be allowed.
